



INTOLERANCE HEALTH TEST SUBMISSION FORM

Step 1 - Print out and complete the test submission form

Please complete 1 per person in capital letters, signing, dating and ticking all necessary boxes.



Step 2 - Include a hair sample

Simply cut as close to the roots or including the roots, a very small hair sample of hair strands (at least 10) approximately 3cms long and place in a dry sealed plastic bag. A good place to gather the sample from is behind their ear. Please take care when cutting.

Write their name, D.O.B and order number on the bag. You mustn't mix samples if you are sending multiple tests together as this will give inaccurate results.



Step 3 - Post the submission and sample

Placing the hair sample along with the submission form in a standard-sized envelope post to the following address, preferably 1st class post to prevent delay of test processing.

If multiple tests are being sent and a larger envelope is used, this will need to be posted at the post office to ensure correct postage fees are paid. This will avoid problems of non-delivery due to incorrect fee payment.

Please ensure full postage fees are paid as we can not be held responsible for tests that are not delivered.
